

# 4Legs Doggy Day Care Terms and Conditions

Your dog's first day at 4Legs Doggy Day Care is an exciting time, not only for your dog and you, but of course, for us too!

Here are some things to keep in mind to ensure your dog's first day with us runs - leaps and bounds - as smoothly as possible...

To ensure the health and safety of your pet and of our staff and clients, we require that all of our clients comply with the following Terms and Conditions

## Health:

o All dogs must be in good health to attend daycare. Please let us know if your dog has been unwell prior to attendance with us, and keep us updated with any changes to their overall health.

o Dogs with stitches CANNOT attend daycare until they have been removed and cleared by a Vet. o Dogs play with their mouths and paws and because of this it is not uncommon for dogs to get a scratch or tooth mark. We pride ourselves on transparency and will notify you immediately should this ever occur.

o Canine Cough is a highly contagious dog-cold that often sweeps through the canine-Community. While it is rare, it is not impossible that your dog may come into contact with a dog who had the virus. Just like children at child care, dogs in the daycare setting are more prone to sharing their doggy germs. We clean our facility daily with Veterinary grade disinfectants to reduce the risk of any germ communication. Speak to one of our friendly staff or your Veterinarian if you have any further questions.

4 Legs Doggy Day Care reserves the right to refuse a dog for daycare if they display signs of a communicable illness, open wound, or are at risk of infection. Please understand this is to ensure the general health and welfare of all dogs in the care of 4Legs Doggy Day Care.

## Age:

We do not have an age requirement at 4Legs Doggy Daycare, instead all dogs who want to come and play must have had their full C5 vaccination (this can happen anywhere between 10 - 16 weeks).

#### **Behaviour:**

Owners will need to endorse that their dog has not harmed or shown threatening behaviour towards any persons or other dogs. We reserve the right to refuse entry to any dog showing threatening behaviour, and revoke the enrolment of dogs who show anti-social behaviours while in our care. 4Legs Doggy Day Care is for well socialised dogs who enjoy dog-to-dog interaction, please consider this when thinking if dog daycare is the best choice for your dog.

#### **Breeds:**

While we love all breeds of dog equally, unfortunately we are currently only accepting small to medium dog breeds only

#### What to bring:

Dogs must wear a flat collar and lead for easy and safe drop off and pick up. Individual named hooks are provided to leave leads, medication or other belongings at 4Legs Doggy Day Care. We have plenty of toys, water bowls, treats and activities for all dogs onsite, so please do not bring any of these from home.

#### Vaccination:

All dogs must have a full C5 Vaccination prior to joining us at 4Legs Doggy Day Care and proof to be supplied for our records – photocopy or email from your Vet is acceptable.

#### **Desexing:**

In line with new, local government policy (under the Dog and Cat Management Act), all dogs OVER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS are required to be desexed before prior to attending daycare.

#### **Registration:**

In Queensland, all dogs must be registered with the local council: before they are 12 weeks old Or within 14 days after moving to a new local council area. Please ensure you dog registration tag is attached to his/her collar.

#### **Opening Hours:**

6:30am – 6:30pm Monday to Friday excluding public holidays and for a short time over the Christmas holiday period.

#### **Bookings:**

Bookings can be made by phone, in person, via text or via email. Dogs may be accepted on the day without bookings, but only if space permits. Regular bookings are encouraged to allow your dog consistency and continuity.

#### Food:

Throughout the day we may feed your dog with small amounts of dog treats. It is your responsibility to advise us of any food allergies or preferences.
